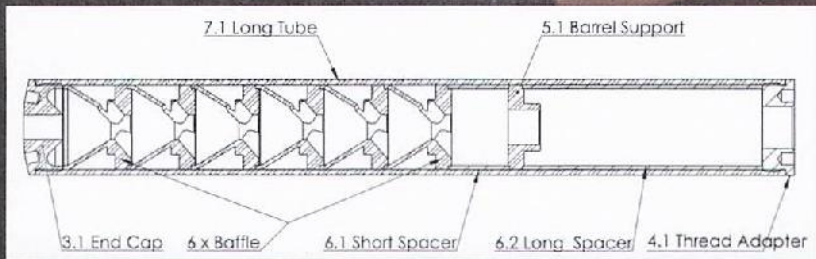

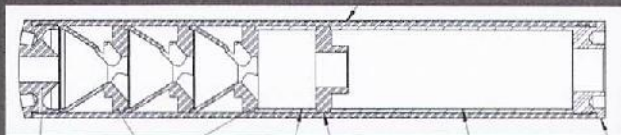

Cleaning and maintenance

Clean barrel ports with SD port brush every 500-700 rounds

One of the most effective methods for cleaning a suppressor is using a simple brush and solvent. This technique is gentle and likely utilizes tools you already have. While it might take some time, you can reach intricate areas without damaging the suppressor. To use this method, you'll need:

- A scrubbing brush (non-metallic recommended)
- A pick (toothpick, punch, flat-head)
- A cloth (terry cloth, microfiber, paper towel)
- A noncorrosive solvent (e.g., diluted Simple Green, Hoppes #9, or CLP)

First, disassemble your suppressor. Soak the tube and baffles in your solvent mixture for a few hours (or overnight for maximum effectiveness). The next day, brush or wipe away any leftover residue, then reassemble the suppressor.
